

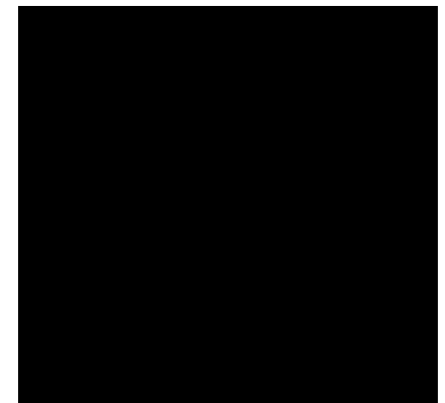

1. WHAT?

- Kingston Road & Lawrence Area
- Morningside Mall

2. WHAT?

**Arts Studio/ Media Arts Centre
WHY?**

This plan addresses to give a safe place for your youth to be, gives our youth a creative outlet, helps them to express and share talents, takes our youth off the street, and uplifts our community

WHERE?

- Guildwood Parkway
- Orton Park
