Meet 1-1 with a Community Employment Specialist to discuss your employment/ training goals. As part of the visit, individuals may be registered with Employment Ontario to receive ongoing employment supports

### Job Search Supports

Opportunity to job search in a group environment with support from a Community Employment Specialist. Open to any job seeker. Bring your resume and/or cover letter.

Wednesday: 12PM - 3PM*

### Youth Job Link/ Youth Job Assistance

Support for youth (age 15-29) looking for their first job. Support provided includes career exploration, career management and skills development.

### Second Career Information Session

Review eligibility and suitability requirements to apply for Second Career Financial Assistance. Monthly information session is typically followed by 1-1 meeting with a Community Employment Specialist.

### Career Conversations

Series of workshops to assist individuals gain knowledge and skills to prepare for the interview process and engaging with potential employers
