- assistance matching skills with job opportunities,

Option #1 – TEST AND HIRE

(Ideal for employers looking to hire permanent staff who require little-to-no training)

- 1 - 2 weeks' max training period
- 100% wage reimbursement
- Minimal administrative paperwork required
- Info relayed/presented to new employee is readily captured and applied

Option #2 – WORK EXPERIENCE

(Ideal for employers hiring contract workers and willing to provide tailored training)

- 6 months' training period
- 60% - 90% reimbursement of wages paid during training period (max. of \$6000)
- Hired on contract and placed on your payroll from the start of training period
- Employer must submit payroll documents after each pay period for reimbursement

Option #3 – PLACEMENT

(Ideal for employers willing to provide training towards a permanent hire)

- 4-6 months' training period
- 60% - 90% reimbursement of wages paid during training period (max. of \$6000)
- Hired on contract and placed on your payroll from the start of training period
- Employer must submit payroll documents after each pay period for reimbursement

Option #4 – APPRENTICESHIP

(Ideal for employers in one of [Ontario's 144 skilled trades](#).)

- 4-6 months' training period
- 60% - 90% reimbursement of wages paid during training period (max. of \$6000)
- Hired on contract and placed on your payroll from the start of training period
- An additional **\$2000 Employer Signing Bonus** is available to employers who hire, register, and train an apprentice for a minimum of 6 months

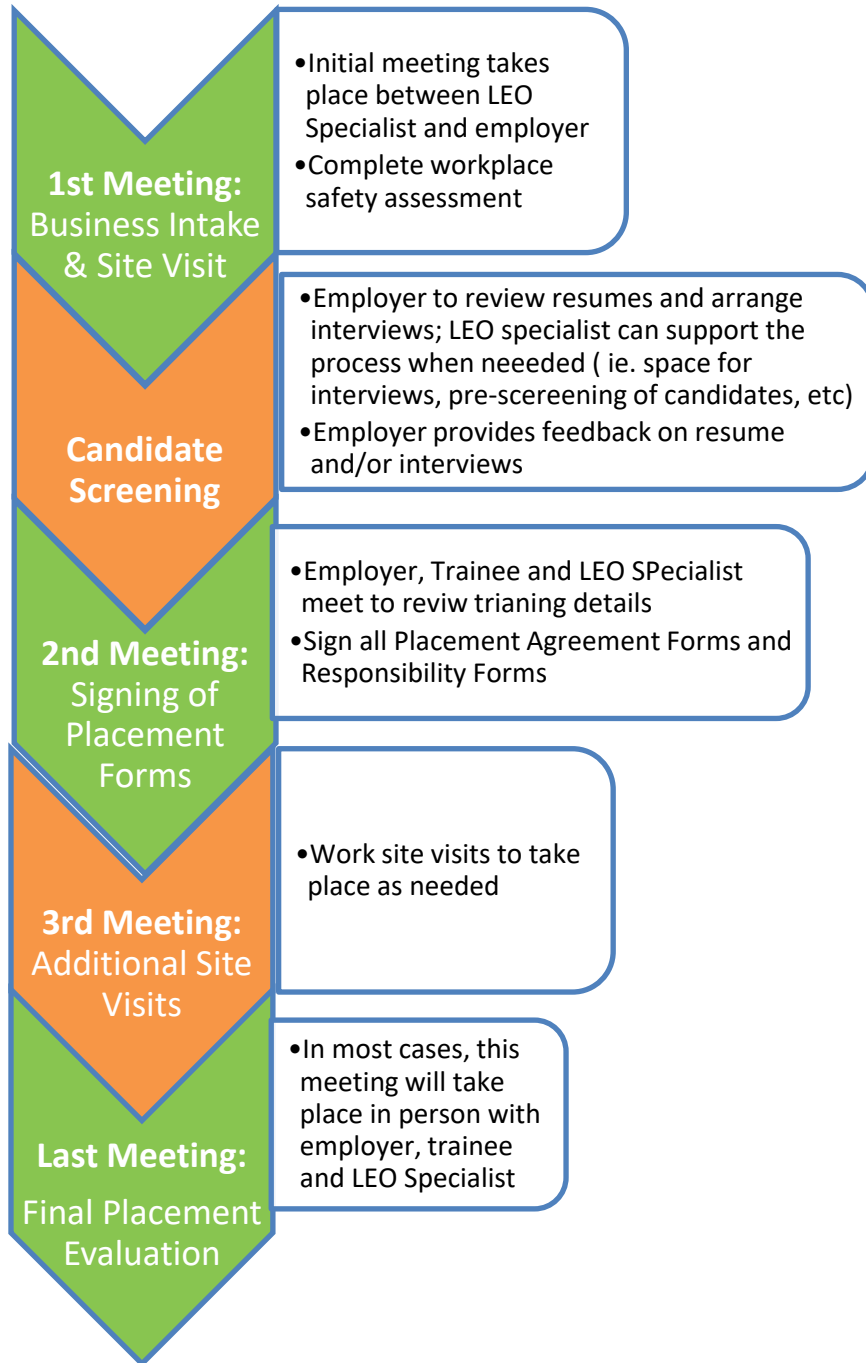
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TRAINING INCENTIVE PROGRAM PROCESS
